To: My Fellow SkyLink Aviation Inc. Professionals

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of SkyLink Aviation Inc. (“**SkyLink**”) recently approved an amendment to SkyLink’s Anticorruption Compliance Manual (the “**Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy**”), which sets forth SkyLink’s policies and procedures relating to compliance with the U.S. Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (“**FCPA**”), the Canadian Corruption of Foreign Public Officials Act (“**CFPOA**”) and other similar laws that may be applicable to SkyLink’s operations. The Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy reiterates policies, procedures and rules which have been in effect for several years, while at the same time seeking to further clarify SkyLink’s policy on bribery, corruption and similar unlawful acts. In short, SkyLink will not tolerate any failure to comply fully with all applicable statutes which seek to prohibit corrupt conduct, including, without limitation, the FCPA and the CFPOA, by any owner, director, officer, employee, agent, advisor, consultant, contractor or other representative of SkyLink, its subsidiaries or its joint ventures.

The Board and SkyLink’s senior management firmly believe that no individual or entity connected to SkyLink, its subsidiaries or its joint ventures has any duty that is more critical than compliance with the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy and statutes seeking to prohibit corrupt conduct generally. Any individual or entity that fails to comply with the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy does so at enormous personal risk and seriously endangers SkyLink. SkyLink shall deal with any such failure promptly and strictly.


In order to ensure that you have all of the tools and resources necessary to understand and comply with the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy, the Board has directed SkyLink’s Chief Compliance Officer, in consultation with SkyLink’s General Counsel and outside counsel, to develop, implement and conduct FCPA and CFPOA related educational and training programs for all Company Persons (as defined in the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy) whose job function is or could be pertinent to FCPA and CFPOA compliance. **See paragraph III** of the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy attached hereto.

The Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy addresses many, but not all, of the issues that may arise in connection with the application of the Policies and Procedures (as defined in the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy) to our Company’s business activities, and sets forth procedures for obtaining additional guidance on compliance with the Policies and Procedures and for reporting deviations from such Policies and Procedures.

I ask you to accept and embrace your responsibilities under the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy and with the strongest possible commitment. I trust you appreciate the fact that the conduct required by the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy is critical to our individual livelihoods and careers as well as to the success and viability of SkyLink. Your faithful and scrupulous attention to the requirements of the Updated Anticorruption Compliance Policy is greatly appreciated by the Board and by me personally.
